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KPMG offers to provide support to third sector organisations. They have worked with previous organisations helping them with:

- Implementation of new IT system and infrastructure.
- Preparation of business case options for board approval.
- Advising on impact assessment report of the work they have been doing.
- Best practice around internal training systems.
- Advice around employee engagement and incentivisation and reward.
- Joining board meetings to provide strategic advice.
- Discussion on business strategy and commercial advice.
- Introduction to KPMG network.

They try not to be too prescriptive about what they can and cannot do as they understand what works for some organisations may not work for others. Their interaction with different organisations is ultimately based on what level of advice they need and what support they need. This might be a one-off discussion on a particular point of a longer working relationship covering a large-scale project.

People have got in touch with them through a variety of different ways such as through events like TSL; through the KPMG network of people they know and people contacting them directly and asking for help.

TSL is the forum in Leeds that promotes, represents and advocates for civil society groups and organisations (known as the ‘Third Sector’) in Leeds. We work closely with large organisations that set the direction for the city, including the Council and the Leeds Clinical Commissioning Group (the NHS) in order to:

- Influence decisions that affect the communities the third sector works with.
- Ensure that as many third sector organisations as possible, particularly the smaller ones, are involved in discussions on city-wide challenges and solutions.
- Ensure third sector organisations can access information and support to help them play their part in changing Leeds for the better.

The work of TSL is guided by a Leadership Group who contribute from the perspective of the field in which they are active (e.g. young people, health and wellbeing, LGBT+). Members are nominated by city forums with particular interests.

Where no forum exists, positions are advertised and TSL Leadership Group members approve representatives into their position based on their skills and experience.
